ATTENTION

New COVID regulations

We can now have 3 persons per 4 msq, with maximum numbers indicated on the doors to each area.


Bush Track Opening Coming Soon Sunday May 16

TUESDAY


Tuesday followed the story of Judas betraying Jesus. The Break Away group planned this night and had plenty of fun puzzling Jesus to the window.

Thank you to all who planned, presented and provided these opportunities.


