Today I gave blood. I was thanked at least six times while I was there by three different people! I even thanked them for taking my blood! For me, for them, and for the eventual recipients of my blood, it is an important thing that I am able to do.

I will never know who my blood will help. The recipient(s), however, will know that blood, life-giving blood, was given for them... freely. Yet, my giving cost me nothing. There was no real sacrifice (apart from a bit of time), and to keep on being effective, I will have to go back every 12 weeks.

Is this just a little, perhaps, of what it was like for the Israelites and the many sacrifices needed to atone for their sins? Having to keep going back time and time again, in order to be "put right" with God?

How blessed we are living this side of the cross, where Jesus offered his own blood once and for all, through his death and resurrection. When Jesus said, "It is finished" as he hung dying on the cross, so much came to an end: never again would life-giving blood need to be shed for the cleansing of sins – the old way had paved the way for the new; Jesus was freed of his human constraints; and 'death was arrested'!

Our future is sure, our sins are forgiven, our hope is in Christ – the old is gone, we are made new in Christ! Hallelujah!

S = Scripture. The key verse.

O = Observation. What the writer meant.

A = Application. How this applies to you.

P = Prayer.
